Thank you for your interest in Harwich Antique Center, located on Route 28 – one of the main thoroughfares on Cape Cod.

The Harwich Antique Center is a group shop of approximately 50 dealers and as many consignors. The main building houses most of these dealers in a dry, temperature controlled environment. Each booth is sectioned off by 5' high moveable "walls" that allow us to customize the size of the booths. The "walls" are outfitted for shelves to be used at the dealer's discretion. Each booth has access to electricity.

Our other building – the "Barn" built in 1842 houses the larger furniture pieces and consignments. In the back area is a workshop where Steve and Pete repair, refinish and refurbish furniture.

Harwich Antique Center is open 10-5 Monday – Saturday and 11-5 Sundays. With extended hours in the summer. We are closed for 4 major holidays – New Year's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

We strive to keep an active presence on our website – www.harwichantiquecenter.com, on Facebook, Craigslist, Pinterest and on EBAY. Dealers are encouraged to participate in our "Saturdays at Harwich Antique Center" events that are open to the public. Most Saturdays we host an antique or community based educational workshop or event. The workshops range in areas of interests including collecting Sandwich glass, cleaning old vinyl records, demonstrating how to clean and restore antique furniture and more. Always popular are our "Free Evaluation Days", where the public is welcome to bring in something to be appraised. The event calendar is printed in local papers, magazines, social media sites, and our website and Cape Cod online events calendars.

As you can see, we are a pro-active, friendly group who strive to increase our public visibility.

Now, back to the basics:

We rent space in the form of booths (various sizes), glass locked cases, shelves, free standing cases and shelves.

Your merchandise must be vintage (1930-1970) or antique (pre-WWI), clean and in good condition. Furniture needs to be clean, free of mold or mildew, and in good condition.

You may decorate your booth as you wish – as long as safety concerns are met.

Each dealer has a specific identification number, by which we track your sales. This number **MUST** be present on each sales tag.

We accept major credit cards.

Dealer checks are prepared monthly and are available on the 7th of each month.
